



The Journey of Navkshitij: History & Key Milestones

- **2003:** Began as a daycare centre for Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (PwIDs), pioneering unique inclusion and development programmes
- 2006: Inspired by our late founder, Dr. Neelima Desai, organised our first Himalayan trek, promoting love for adventure and infusing confidence among PwIDs; successfully led nine treks for PwIDs in the Himalayan region since
- **2007:** Established the Marunji Residential Rehabilitation Centre on unused government land, with support from trustees, parents, donors and staff
- 2012: Took our PwIDs on an international trip to Thailand
- **2015:** Recognition for Dr. Neelima Desai from the Sakal Social Foundation and Guru Nanak Foundation for her contribution to special education
- 2018: Excellence Award by Autism Connect & Neuro Gen presented to Dr. Neelima Desai by Hon. Shri Rajkumar Badole, Minister for Social Justice of Maharashtra
- **2023:** Opened a new residential unit in Talegaon, accommodating 40 PwIDs, alongside the 47 residents at the Marunji centre

In 2024, after a long time, we organised a trip to Kerala, God's own country. This was a six-day tour planned for 26 special friends who were accompanied by seven staff members. Our special friends were on top of the cloud as they flew from Mumbai to Trivandrum and back from Kochi to Mumbai by Air India. They visited the Kanyakumari temple and the Swami Vivekananda Rock Memorial located in the sea. They then visited the Lord Padmanabhaswamy in Trivandrum. Next, they went to Alleppey for a boat house ride. Alleppey is famous for boat races, beaches, marine products and the coir industry. They spent almost a day in the boat house, enjoying the delicious local cuisine served on the boat. Coconut and coconut oil are generously used in this region.

After a refreshing boat house ride, our Friends went to Munnar, which is surrounded by rolling hills dotted with tea plantations, and to the Eravikulam National Park, a habitat for the endangered mountain goat Nilgiri tahr. Our Friends were thrilled to see the Nilgiri tahr. They also visited the Botanical Garden, Eco Point and the Madhupetti Dam. It was a splendid experience for our Friends. They came back with great memories.









Climbing New Heights: Parvati Hill Competition 2024

Navkshitij has been organising the Parvati Hill Climbing Competition since 2009, on the first Wednesday of February. The Parvati Hill is a significant landmark in the city of Pune. Every year, more than 300 people with intellectual disabilities (PwIDs) participate in this event. In 2024, for the first time, we received tremendous response from Autistic Friends. A total of 315 PwIDs participated in the 2024 edition. Approximately 50 young volunteers and 25 senior citizens helped us conduct this event. The event was flagged off by Dr. Chandrashekhar Desai, the president of Navkshitij. Nitor Infotech Pvt Ltd has been sponsoring this competition.









Dr. Neelima Desai Karandak: Interschool Drama Competition for PwIDs

Dr. Neelima Desai Karandak is an interschool drama competition initiated in 2008. Formerly known as Natya Mahostav, this contest is hosted by Navkshitij for PwIDs from other organisations as well as ours. In 2022, our Natya Mahostav was renamed Dr. Neelima Desai Karandak. Around 12 to 14 organisations/schools for PwIDs from Pune and other parts of Maharashtra participate in this event.

Every year, the PwIDs present plays on current issues such as Shrawa Bal, Com. Govind Pansare & Com. Narendra Dabholkar, Save the Girl Child, Save Trees Save Life, Gender Equality, Save the Environment, and Anti-Terrorism. Friends, relatives and well-wishers are invited to watch them perform. Well-known theatre and film personalities are invited as judges. Since 2012, Emcure Pharmaceuticals Ltd. has been sponsoring the event.
